Cleaning Checklist (or any time you want the house looking fabulous)

YOUR HOUSE MUST BE MOVE-IN-READY. THIS MEANS "WHITE GLOVE" TREATMENT!
YOU WOULDN'T WANT TO LIVE WITH SOMEONE ELSE'S GRIME SO PAY YOUR BUYER THE SAME RESPECT.

Floors Bathrooms Vacuum, sweep and/or mop every room in the house! Don't Scrub every surface including shelves, toilets, tubs, forget to reach below furniture and into corners. showers, mirrors, faucets and sinks. Clean floors and walls. Make sure to remove any moisture Steam clean carpets (professional job is best) staining that has formed on walls (usually found where Usindows towels hang). Clean all towel rails and toilet paper holders. Clean inside and out! Windows are often a feature when selling a home. Due to the natural light, It is very obvious Grout when they haven't been cleaned properly. Remove all screens, place in shower and use shower head Scrub well. For really soiled areas, use a grout cleaner or 3 parts baking soda to 1 part peroxide. Mix and leave 15 to clean thoroughly. minutes then scrub with a brush. Clean window sills and frames as dust and fingerprints often build up here. Caulking Light Switches and Outlets Caulking does not age well, especially if not painted over. It can dry up, shrink and leave voids (no longer serving its Frequent use leaves many fingerprints, oil and dirt that purpose) or discolour. Scrub discoloured caulking well or those living in the house can often overlook. Avoid a consider replacing entirely (usually easier). potential buyer flipping a switch to find an unwelcome surprise! M/19/9088 Trim and Baseboards Clean mirrors and frames to provide clear reflective surfaces and soft glow within the house. Wipe down and consider repainting if scuffed or marked. Sinks and Faucets Wipe a dryer sheet along to deter dust from settling here. Kitchens Clean well into edges and corners for hidden grime. Shine faucets and handles for a polished look. Clean cupboards, shelves and drawers inside and out. Light Fixtures and Fans Empty to allow easy access and thorough cleaning; then neatly place all items going back in. This is a good time to Dust light fixtures and ceiling fan blades. pre-pack any items that won't be needed during the time Wash shades where flies have been (for droppings). you're selling. It will help declutter and organize your Dust ceiling, especially around these fixtures. kitchen! Check cupboard doors for food or drink drips- especially (dours near sink where water drips may be frequent. Bake half of a lemon for 15 minutes. Clean cupboard doors around handles where fingerprints are frequent. Boil cinnamon sticks and/or lemon/orange in water.

Shine appliances inside and out

Leave containers with baking soda hidden.

Open windows to let fresh air in whenever possible.
